Special Presentation

Martyna Griffin, Keep Carroll Beautiful Director, addressed the Board of Commissioners giving a brief overview of the community grant, "Made to Be Remade". The county will use trailers to move aluminum cans from the convenience centers to the recycling facility. It will be a pilot program to find ways to efficiently move smaller and lighter recyclables to save the county money. Natalie Johnson-Russell, Keep Georgia Beautiful Foundation, addressed the group stating that they are a sustainable partner along with Kevin Perry from the Georgia Beverage Association. Mr. Perry made the presentation of \$17,000 awarded to Keep Carroll Beautiful.

Financial Recap – August, 2025

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2.I. August, 2025 Financials
-Alecia Searcy, Finance Director

County Finance Director, Alecia Searcy, presented the financial recap of County funds as of August 2025, reporting revenues to date totaling \$7,935,000, expenditures to date totaling \$15,789,069 with a percentage of realized revenue of 9.29% and expenses of 18.48% of budget.

In regard to the 2015 SPLOST, no expenditures for FY26, interest income only.

In regard to the 2021 SPLOST, \$2,915,000 in expenses mainly for the Administration Building and Public Works. We received \$2,863,000 in revenue SPLOST receipts and interest income. We have payments to the city of \$853,000.

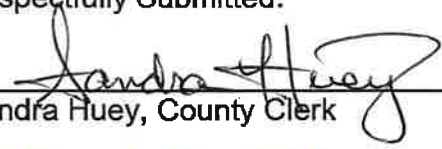
