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**Financial Recap**

**1.I. Financial Recap for February 2026**  
**-Alecia Searcy, Finance Director**

County Finance Director, Alecia Searcy, presented the financial recap as of February 28, 2026 reporting revenues to date totaling \$67,931,605 with expenses totaling \$59,255,340. The general fund balance is \$455,251,680. Director Searcy gave a brief update on the 2021 SPLOST and the 2015 SPLOST financials.

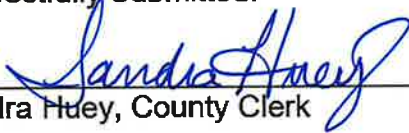
